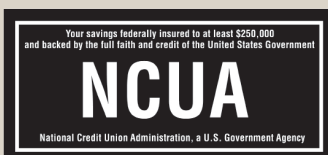

Special Patronage Dividends Distributed



For the third consecutive year, Hometown Credit Union is pleased to announce that the credit union members have received a special patronage dividend! The dividend is based on the average monthly balance of member's deposits and loans during 2016. A total of \$730,000 has been given back to the members the past three years. This year \$308,700 was distributed to members. Please review your statement to see the amount deposited to your regular share savings account. All special patronage dividends that calculated at less than \$1.00 were not paid. It was not feasible for Hometown Credit Union to post these small credits because administrative costs exceeded the value of the dividend. No special patronage dividends were paid on accounts that were closed during 2016 and the first quarter of this year. The special dividend will not affect your 2016 taxes, but will be included on your 2017 1099-INT form.

We will be the first Credit Union to serve the residents of Lincoln and the surrounding developments.
