# SPECIAL PATRONAGE DIVIDENDS DISTRIBUTED

For the 8th consecutive year, Hometown Credit Union is pleased to announce that the credit union members have received a special patronage dividend! The dividend is based on the average monthly balance of members' deposits and loans during 2021. Nearly \$3 million has been given back to the members the past eight years. This year, \$544,375 was distribued to members. Please review your statement to see the amount deposited to your regular share savings account. All special patronage dividends that calculated at less than \$1.00 were not paid. It was not feasible for Hometown Credit Union to post these small credits because administrative costs exceeded the value of the dividend. No special patronage dividends were paid on accounts that were closed during 2021 and the first quarter of this year. The special dividend will not affect your 2021 taxes, but will be included on your 2022 1099-INT form.

# EASTER BRUNCH CINNAMON ROLL CAKE

### Cake:

3 c. Flour 1/4 tsp. Salt

1 c. Sugar

4 tsp. Baking Powder

1 1/2 c. Milk

2 Eggs

2 tsp. Vanilla

½ c. Butter, melted

## Topping:

1 c. Butter, melted

1 c. Brown Sugar

2 Tbs. Flour

1 Tbs. Cinnamon

#### Glaze:

2 c. Powdered Sugar 5 Tbs. Milk 1 tsp. Vanilla Mix the cake ingredients together, except for the butter. Slowly, stir in the melted butter and pour into a greased 9x13 inch pan.

For the topping, mix all of the ingredients together until well combined. Drop evenly over the batter and swirl with a knife.

Bake at 350 for 28-32 minutes.

While warm, drizzle the glaze over the cake.

Enjoy this warm, simple and delicious alternative to a cinnamon roll! You may even decide you like these better!
