

# Special Patronage Dividends Distributed


For the 10th consecutive year, Hometown Credit Union is pleased to announce that the credit union members have received a special patronage dividend! The dividend is based on the average monthly balance of members' deposits and loans during 2023. This year, \$602,893 was distributed to members. Please review your statement to see the amount deposited to your regular share savings account. All special patronage dividends that calculated at less than \$1.00 were not paid. It was not feasible for Hometown Credit Union to post these small credits because administrative costs exceeded the value of the dividend. No special patronage dividends were paid on accounts that were closed during 2023 and the first quarter of this year. The special dividend will not affect your 2023 taxes, but will be included on your 2024 1099-INT form.


